Missing Parts - R100R 1992 Models

Due to vendor shortages in Berlin, some motorcycles were shipped without the following parts:

- Riders Manuals
- Air Pressure Labels
- Cylinder Protection Bar/Side Stand
- Incorrect passenger grab handle

We decided not to delay production until December (with January delivery), and are air-shipping the above parts separately in order to maximize your sales for 1991.

The above missing parts will be handled in the following ways:

VIN of motorcycle

It is imperative that the manual and label are with the motorcycle at the time of sale to the retail purchaser. This is a Federal Law. The label should be affixed to the rear fender or tool box tray lid.

Cylinder Protection Bar/

Side Stand:

Our Distribution Department will ship these to each dealer who receives an R100R missing these parts.

Our factory has informed us which motorcycles are shorted. Therefore, the Cylinder Protection Bar/Side Stand will be sent just as Ownership Kits are sent. However, arrival of the kit may be delayed for the very first motorcycles sent to your dealership.

Warranty Claim: Use a standard Warranty Claim form with the following information for claiming Labor Time after installing the Cylinder Protect Bar:

Flat Rate No.: 46 71 265

There is no need to claim any parts, as these will be sent free-of-charge.

Passenger Grab Handle:

All motorcycles will have a grab handle. However, you may notice they are not painted properly, or there is no mounting position for saddle bag mounts. The correct grab handle should be bi-packed with each crate or, in some cases, already installed.

The grab handle should have three (3) mounting positions where it attaches to the frame. Two positions are for mounting; the third is for mounting the saddle bag mounts.

Warranty Claim:

Use a standard Warranty Claim Form with the following information for claiming labor time after installing the grab handle:

Defect Code No. 00 00 46 17 00
Flat Rate Units: 5 (25 min.)

Flat Rate No. 46 51 099

There is no need to claim any parts, as these come with each motorcycle.
