Subject: Oil consumption R 25/3 during the running-in period

The aspiration system of the R 25/3 motorcycles, prolonged far in front of the carburettor, provides highly improved air cleaning. This results in a diminished cylinder and piston ring wear, so that the running-in period of piston rings has been increased from 1,200 to 2,400 miles.

The running-in speeds up to 1,200 miles, as indicated in the Manual, should still be observed.

The especially turned piston rings, however, will not bear in the finest way unless a mileage up to 2,400 will have been covered.

During this period an oil consumption of 1.2 to 1.5 litres per 1000 kilometres (about 2000 to 1600 miles per US.gall.) should be considered a regular figure.
