Dear Sirs,

Subject: Attaching "Standard" Sidecar to R 25/2 Models

In order to increase riding safety and to simplify the attachment of a sidecar, all four connections on the motorcycle have been designed now as quick-action ball-and-socket joints.

The two lower connection balls are solidly welded to all frames (normally on the right-hand side), whereas the upper balls should be clamped under the steering head, i.e. flange-connected on frame, beneath the saddle. To fit a sidecar to machines already delivered, these connection fittings are to be ordered separately under collective spare part No. 225 2 96 600 20 for attaching the sidecar to the right-hand side, and under spare part No. 225 2 96 601 20 for attaching the sidecar to the left of motorcycle.

The attachment of a sidecar is carried out according to measures and sequency for fitting operations, as indicated by our circular-letter Sidecar Group No. 2/52, while the clamp joint of the front brace should be connected last without tension to the lower attachment point of the sidecar chassis.
